By law, a household goods carrier cannot transport dangerous substances as defined in the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act of Canada.

Many everyday items, such as those identified below, are dangerous goods or are articles that could cause serious accidents or damage to your possessions. It is your responsibility to ensure that you dispose of these common
